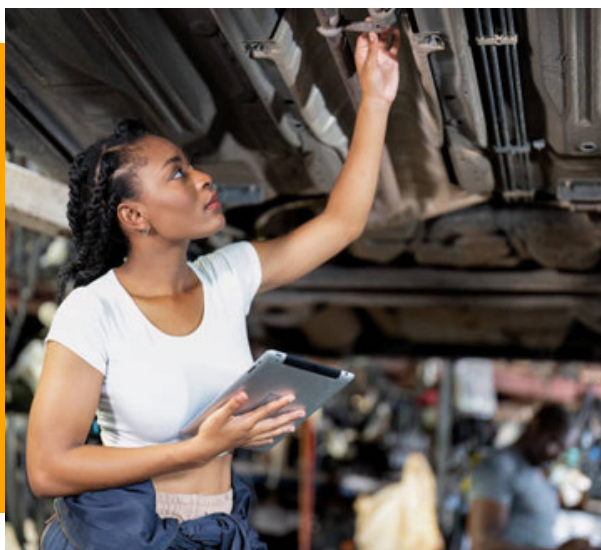

# YOUR VOICE YOUR POWER



[Register to Vote](#)

Effective June 1, 2023, your criminal record does NOT affect your right to vote in Minnesota unless you are currently incarcerated for a felony conviction.

This is a historic law that is estimated to affect more than 55,000 people in MN alone. Please use your power and your voice!

## You can vote if...

- you were charged with or convicted of a misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor.
- you are in jail, but are not currently serving a felony sentence.
- you have been charged with a felony, but you haven't been convicted.
- you have been given a stay of adjudication.
- you have been convicted of a felony, but are not incarcerated.

## You cannot vote if...

- you are currently incarcerated serving a felony sentence.

# VOTING WITH A CRIMINAL RECORD



////////////////////////////////////

*Your criminal record does NOT affect your right to vote in Minnesota unless you are currently incarcerated serving a felony conviction sentence.*

## VOTING AFTER A FELONY CONVICTION

You can vote if you are not currently incarcerated for a felony sentence, if you are on probation or parole, or if your felony conviction did not include incarceration.

As long as you are not incarcerated, you can vote. You will need to register to vote. It is best to register before Election Day, but it is not required.

## NOT SURE ABOUT YOUR LEGAL STATUS?

If you have any questions about your eligibility to vote following a criminal conviction, contact the Secretary of State's Office.
